# Swarnandhra College of Engineering & Technology (Autonomous) Plagiarism Policy

The faculty's work must be focused on innovative thoughts and be protected by Zero Tolerance Policy of Plagiarism.

'The reporting of work shall have all necessary components of the core work which includes 'Abstract', 'Keywords', 'Introduction, 'Objective, 'Hypothesis', 'Research Methodology', 'Analysis and Evaluation', 'Description and 'Findings', 'Conclusions', 'Recommendations', and 'References'. Students, researchers, and faculty members should not undertake any academic misconduct by stealing intellectual property in any way, according to the UGC (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations of 2018. As a consequence, correct attribution, author consent where required, and source recognition that is consistent with the needs and particularities of disciplines, as well as the source's rules and regulations, are all important.

Plagiarism would be evaluated in the following situations:

1	Level 1	Similarities below 10%	The author shall be asked to correct the paper and resubmit.	Minor Similarity, No penalty
2	Level 2	Similarities above 10% to 40%	Shall be asked to withdraw manuscript submitted for publication	-
3	Level 3	Similarities above 40% to 60%	Shall be asked to withdraw manuscript submitted for publication	Shall not be allowed to be a supervisor to any UG, PG, Ph.D. student /scholar for a period of two years
4	Level 4	Similarities above 60%	Shall be asked to withdraw manuscript submitted for publication and shall not be allowed to publish any work for <b>two</b> years	Shall not be allowed to be a supervisor to any UG, PG, Ph.D. student /scholar for a period of three years

#### **Citation Guidelines**

In which more than 20 words but less than 100 words are taken from some published work, a reference citation is needed.

When quoting more than 100 words from a work, the text should be separated by inverted commas.

If the cited Citation is from an open internet site, 30% of common content is deemed plagiarism, and the article may not be considered for publishing or further consideration.

In the case of some material taken from another site, authors are required to cite the source.
