During Discussion: Points Raised by Sri P. Udaya Bhaskar Garu**Point 1:**

Observation: In the Income and Expenditure Statement, the income from Bus Fee and Hostel Fee is reflected under the Income Head; however, the corresponding expenditure is not shown under the Expenditure Head.

Minutes:

The Governing Body discussed the observation in detail. It was clarified that the financial statement presented was a consolidated statement and certain operational expenditures related to transport and hostel facilities were accounted for under common administrative and establishment expenditure heads. The Principal informed the members that, from the next financial year onwards, separate expenditure heads for Transport and Hostel operations will be incorporated in the Income and Expenditure Statement to provide greater transparency and facilitate better financial analysis. The Governing Body appreciated the suggestion and advised the Finance Committee to implement the same.

Point 2:

Observation: The proposed Library Budget of ₹10,00,000 appears to be low when compared with the overall institutional budget of approximately ₹50 Crores.

Minutes:

The Governing Body deliberated on the allocation for library resources. It was explained that the present allocation was based on the immediate procurement requirements, considering the availability of adequate printed books, digital library resources, e-journals, and subscriptions already in place. However, the Governing Body recommended that the library budget be reviewed periodically based on accreditation requirements, emerging technologies, research activities, and the academic needs of students and faculty. The Library Committee was advised to prepare a comprehensive annual resource augmentation plan for consideration during budget revision.

Point 3:

Observation: Action plan to improve campus placements.

Minutes:

The Principal presented the initiatives being undertaken to strengthen placement activities. The Governing Body suggested implementing a structured placement improvement strategy that includes strengthening industry collaborations, enhancing internship opportunities, conducting regular aptitude and soft-skill training

programmes, increasing technical certification courses, organizing coding and domain-specific skill development programmes, inviting reputed companies for campus recruitment, strengthening alumni engagement, and establishing Centre of Excellence in emerging technologies. The Placement Cell was instructed to prepare a semester-wise action plan with measurable targets and submit periodic progress reports to the Governing Body.

Point 4:

Observation: Plans for obtaining Deemed-to-be-University/Private University status and preparation of a Detailed Project Report (DPR) or Action Plan for improving NIRF Ranking.

Minutes:


The Governing Body discussed the long-term institutional vision of achieving greater academic autonomy and improving national rankings. It was resolved that the institution shall initially focus on strengthening key performance parameters such as research publications, patents, funded projects, consultancy, innovation ecosystem, faculty development, student outcomes, international collaborations, and industry partnerships, which are essential for improving NIRF rankings. The Principal informed the members that a strategic roadmap and Detailed Project Report (DPR) for institutional growth, including the feasibility of pursuing Deemed-to-be-University or Private University status, will be prepared after detailed consultation with experts and stakeholders. A committee will be constituted to formulate a comprehensive five-year strategic plan aligned with the institution's vision and national ranking parameters.

Resolution:

The Governing Body appreciated the valuable suggestions made by Sri P. Udaya Bhaskar Garu. It was resolved that the recommendations would be incorporated into the institution's strategic planning process, and the respective committees shall submit Action Taken Reports (ATRs) in the subsequent Governing Body Meeting.
