ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

Purpose

We believe new student orientation is a very important component of student's successful transition to a demanding stream like engineering. The Orientation Programme is designed to make the first year commencing students aware of the academic, cultural and social environment at the college. The programme rolls out with the key strategic goals of the college

Orientation

Swarnandra College of Engineering and Technology(SCET) organizes "Orientation Programme" for the first year students every year. The objective of the programme is to formally welcome the newly arrived students to SCET family and assist them in starting their academic journey. SCET organized Orientation Programme for parents and students of first year engineering on 12th October ,2022.

The programme commenced with a warm welcome to the parents and students followed by the ceremonial lighting of the lamp by our Principal Dr.S Suresh Kumar accompanied by the Honourable members of the Management. The students of various branches addressed the gathering.The Management members ,Shri K.V.Satyanarayana Garu, Chairman,Shri K .Venkateswara Swamy Garu, Treasurer, Shri Srihari Garu ,Director addressed the gathering. They stated that students need to take an active role in their learning to achieve academic success, bridging the gap between academics and industry. After their addressing, this session was taken over by all the department heads and the versatile Principal, Dr. S Suresh garu, who

briefed about the state of the art infrastructure of the campus. Later all the HODs spoke to the students.

After that, Dr. V.Swaminatham Garu, HOD ,Basic Sciences and Humanities, gave a brief presentation to the students and parents. In that presentation, the students were made aware of syllabus, tests, term work, practical exams & overall academic pattern to be followed during the first year of engineering. He encouraged all the admitted students for study time management. A detailed list of rules and regulations about discipline and etiquettes, and other official formalities were instructed to the students.

INDUCTION PROGRAMME

The Induction programme was brought in with a view to uplift the level of the entrants to an elevated stage, promote all-round development and exposing learners' stigmas to minimize and to maximize their learning. Learners come with diverse thoughts, backgrounds & perceptions. Hence it becomes important to help them adjust to the new environment & inculcate the ethos of the institution with a sense of larger purpose. That is where the lacuna lies which demands a program dynamic enough to address the issue. SCET has organized a Three days induction programme with an objective to provide ample of time and a platform for the transition of students from school to the hard-core engineering.

The Jawahar Lal Nehru Technological University, Kakinada has prescribed Induction program for three weeks from 12- 5th Nov 2022.

INDUCTION PROGRAM

1) 13,14 Oct 22: Physical Activities- Sports,Yoga and Meditation ,Plantation:

Students were taken to the college gym and were showed the various indoor games and gym appliances.Students actively played the games and used the gym facilities. Students were taken to the seminar hall for practicing Yoga and Meditation branch wise.students were taken to the key places in the campus to plant trees. Students were imparted yoga training by Guruji Prasad Raju garu and his student Teja Acharya garu to enlighten them the importance of the fit body and mind they need to possess.Students actively took part in the session .

2)17,18 Oct 22: Career Counselling; A two day work shop on “Life Skills”was imparted to the freshers.Imparting life skills to the younger generation improves their decision making ability,enables to face the challenges of life.Dr.V V Krishna Chintala and his wifeDr.Radha Chintala delivered their valuable perspectives and insights to the students.

3)19,20th Oct 22: Orientation to all branches-career options,tools,etc:Students were introduced to their respective departments and were shown various laboratories and the instruments were introduced.The career options were told to the students.

4)21,22nd Oct 22: Orientation on admitted Branch-corresponding labs tools and platforms: The students were introduced to their respective departments and labs.

5)25,26th Oct 22: Proficiency Modules and Productivity Tools: . This module is to help fill the gaps in basic competency required for further inputs to be absorbed. It includes effort to make student proficient in

interpersonal communication and expression as well as awareness about linguistic and thereafter NLP. Productivity tools are software designed to simplify tasks, streamline workflow and often include features that allow you to access documents quickly, create charts and graphs to visualize project planning, progress, etc., and collaborate with other people. Students were taught how to access these techniques.

6) 27, 28th Oct 22: Assessment on basic aptitude and mathematical skills: Students were given classes to understand the basic aptitude. Mathematical skills were taught as well as the maths they learnt in the previous classes was brushed up.

7) 29, 31st Oct 22: Remedial Training in Foundation Courses: the students were given basic knowledge in the foundation courses.

8) 1, 2 Nov 22: Human values and Professional Ethics: Students were taught the importance of the Human Values and the ethics they need to follow in their work place.

9) 3, 4th Oct 22: Communication Skills –focus on Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing Skills: The communication skills were imparted by Dr. Zehrabi. She taught the importance of the skills which help in all spheres of life.

10) 5th Oct 22: Concepts of Programming: The concepts of programming were introduced and taught very effectively by Dr. Srinivasulu. Students followed the sessions with apt interest.



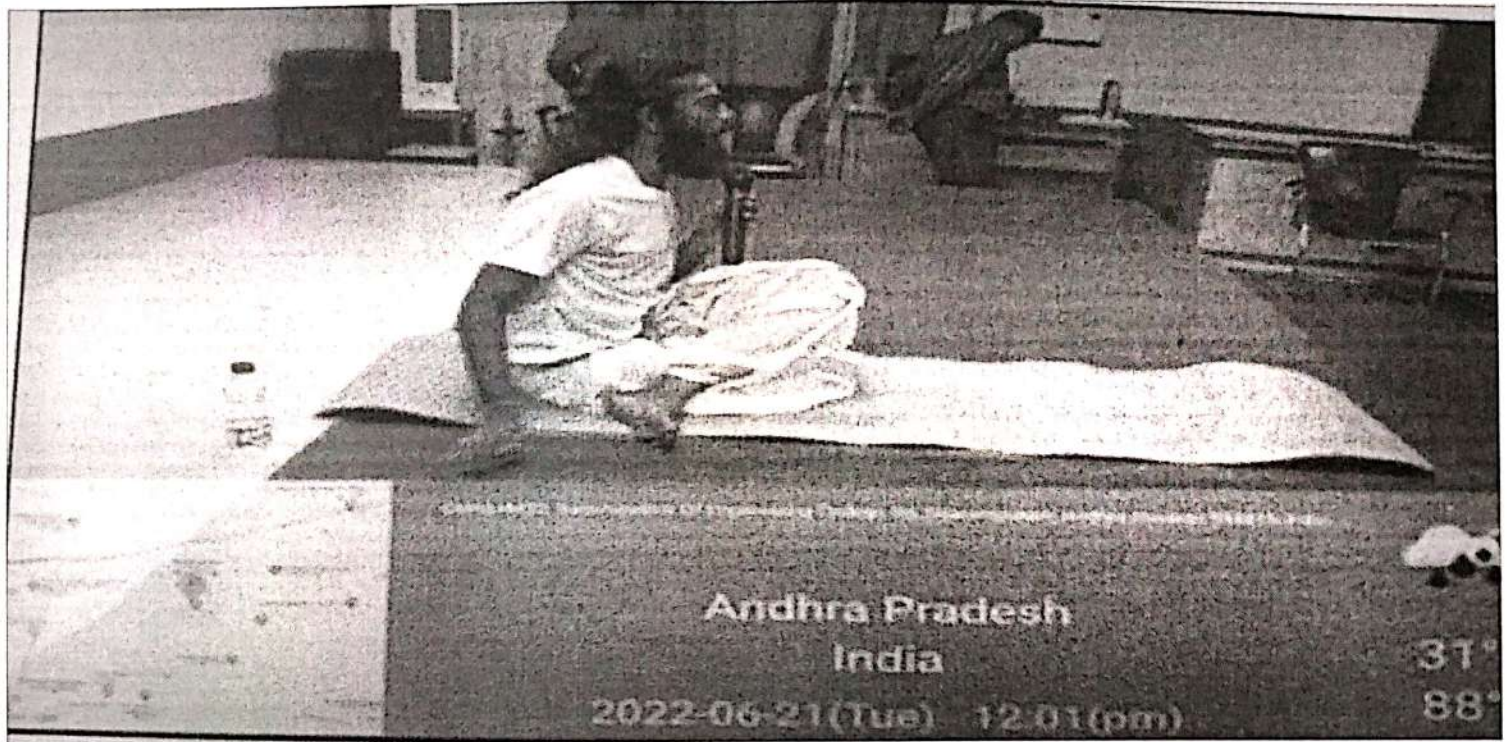
