8) 20th Sep23: Human values and Professional Ethics: Students were taught the importance of the Human Values and the ethics they need to follow in their work place.

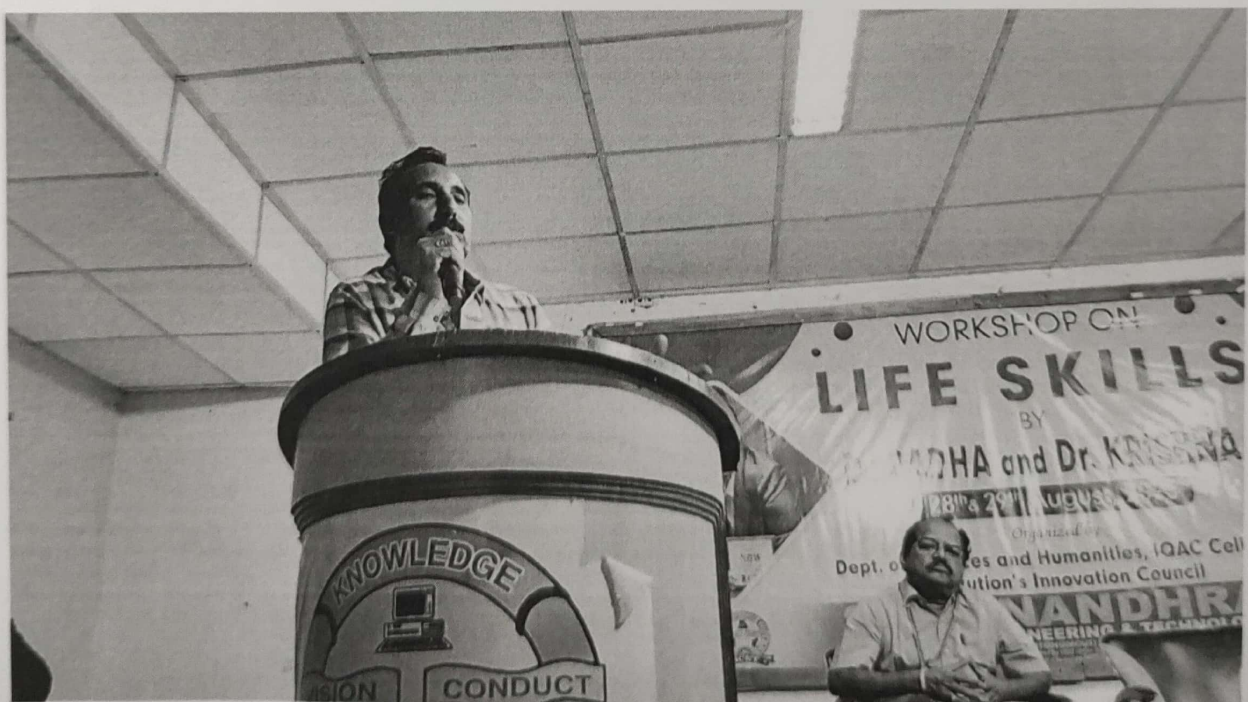

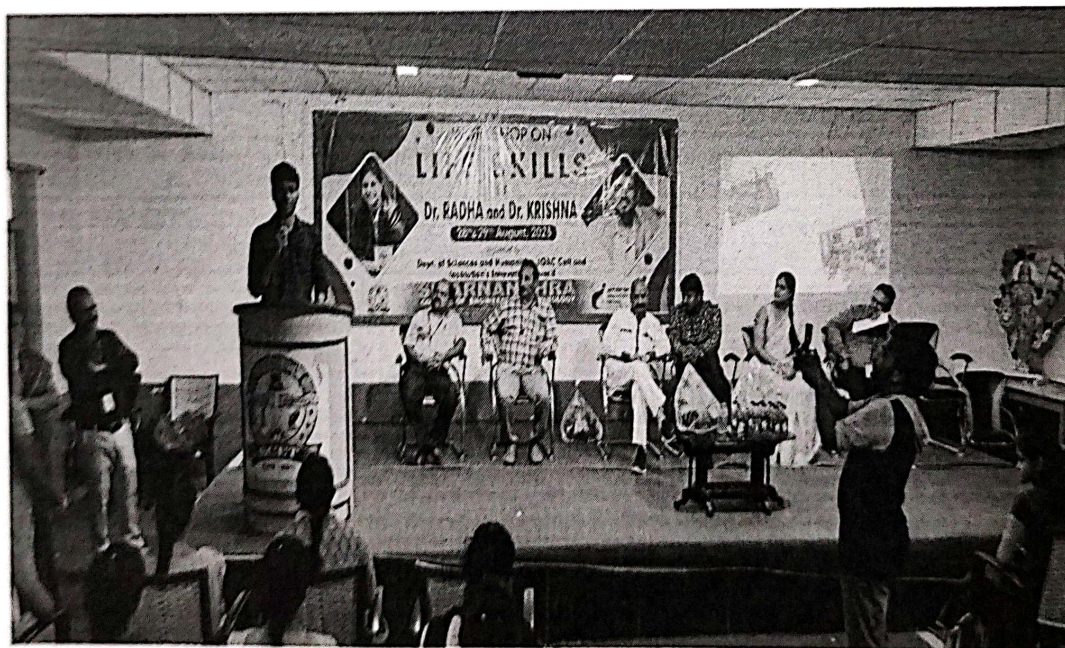
