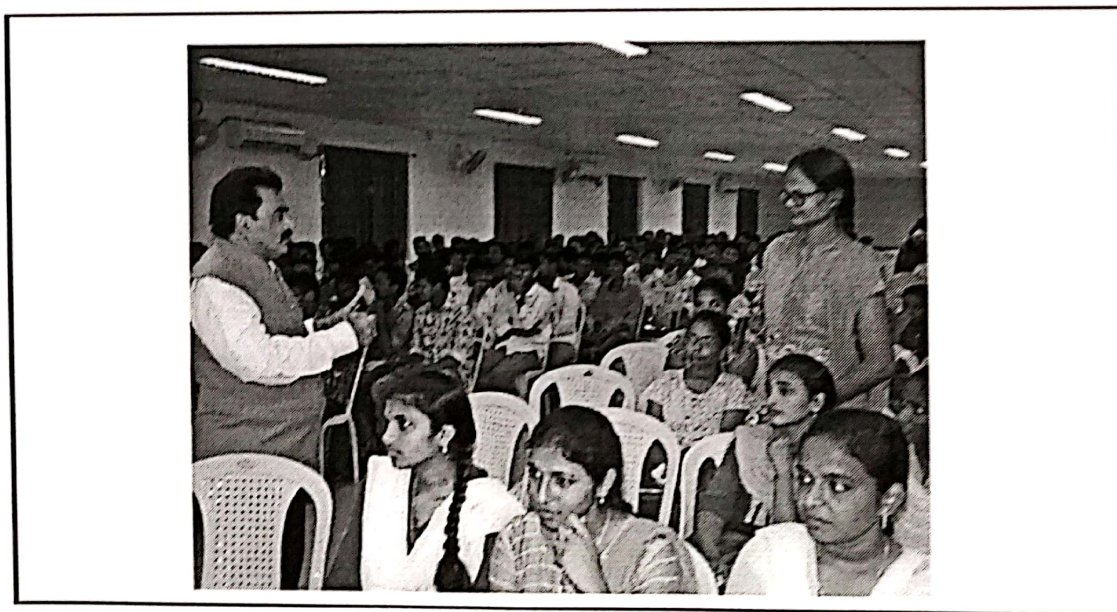
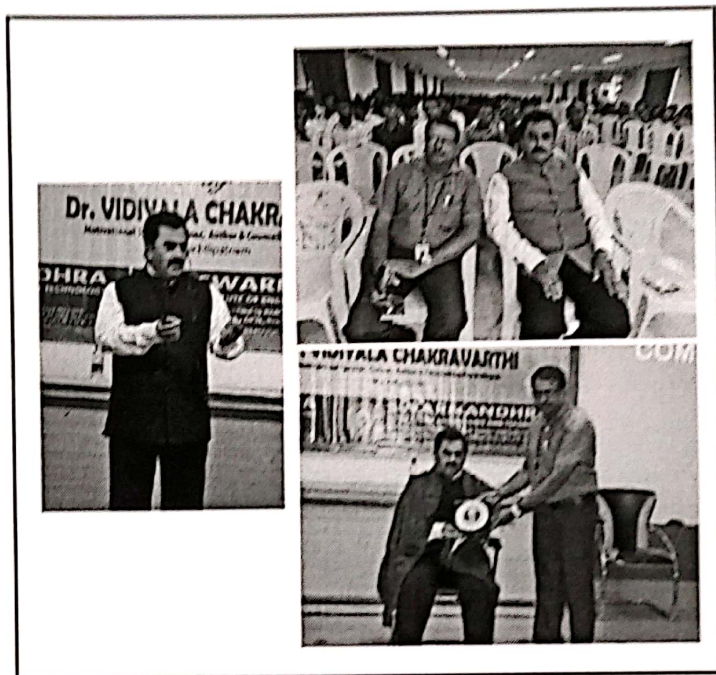
- **Objectives:-**
